\*Each group receives 1 point for each state into which their Article V resolution is introduced; 1 point in each chamber if it passes all committees (2 pts for unicameral NE); 1 point in each chamber when it passes on the floor (2 pts - NE); and 1 point when the application is final. Thus, a total of 6 points can be earned in each state. The completion goal is 204 points (34 states passed x 6 pts./state). If an application dies during or at the end of a non-carryover legislative session, then points generated for that cycle are not counted. **NOTE:** DNP = voted down, tabled, withdrawn, died on calendar, not reached, or otherwise did not progress. Underscored states carry legislation over to 2016. Some groups did not respond to contact efforts so scoring is based on available public information and may have some inaccuracies. General or open convention calls are not aggregated in this report.
