## STATEMENT OF THE FACTS

I am the John C. Guise who sent a letter and enclosures dated January 12, 2012, to Eric H. Holder, Jr., the Attorney General of the United States, concerning a complaint against each and every member of Congress relating to their violations of oath of office and failure to call an Article V convention.

At 9:08 AM today, I placed a phone call to 202-514-1152 (the Correspondence Specialist, Management Unit of the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice. An unidentified person responded to my call.

I asked the unnamed person to provide me with the status of my complaint. That person told me that the Criminal Division had referred my complaint to the FBI for further investigation, and that the FBI had decided not to pursue the matter. Under further questioning, the unnamed person was unable to answer any of my questions.

I immediately called the Attorney General's office at 202-514-2063 and "Marcella" answered the phone. I asked Marcella if she could verify that the Attorney General had notified the court of the referral to the Criminal Division pursuant to Executive Order 10452. She told me that she could not do so.

I immediately placed a call to the Courtroom Deputy at the U. S. District Court at 202-354-3192 and got the voicemail for Robert Elliotte. I left a message asking him to call me. At 10:41 AM today, Mr. Elliotte returned my call. I asked him if he had any record of any notification relating to the DOJ referral to the Criminal Division pursuant to the federal statute. He replied in the negative. I asked him what he would do if he were me. He said that he would file a case with the D. C. District Court.

I state that all of the above is absolutely true and correct this 24<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2012.
